WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT FROM SERVING ON WORK CREW?

WORK EXPERIENCE – Work Crew members work **hard** during camp. Cleaning dishes (750 place settings daily!), toilets, sinks, and floors takes up a huge part of every day (don't think you are coming to camp for a holiday!). Yet, in the midst of all of this, there will be time every day for recreation – sand volleyball, tubing, rock climbing, and more! Your day will also include laughter, spontaneous fun, Leadership Training Units (LTU's), and many new relationships that become deep and rich as the days go by.

SPIRITUAL GROWTH – You will be challenged and stretched as you build relationships through daily activities, Bible studies, and discussion times. You will be asked to go beyond your normal limits, and as you do so you will be able to see God work in and through you. Whatever the summer brings, it will provide ample opportunity for you to trust God more.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT – Ness Lake Bible Camp places an emphasis on skill development. You will have the opportunity to learn and participate in a range of activities through LTU's.
