Optional paid activities such as high ropes and paintball may be available weather permitting.

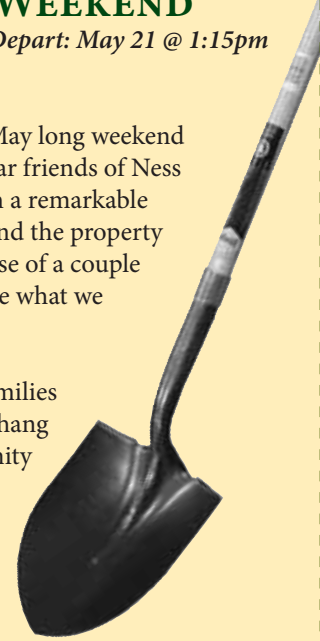


FAMILY WORK WEEKEND
